What is the L-952 All-Hazards Public Information Officer Course? The purpose of this professional development course is to provide local and state-level emergency responders with an overview of key duties and responsibilities of a Public Information Officer Type III in a Type III All Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT).

What are the requirements?

A student may not miss more than 10% (4 hours total) of this course in order to receive a certificate of completion.

Prerequisites are:

- ICS 100 Introduction to the Incident Command System
- ICS 200 Basic Incident Command System
- ICS 300 Intermediate Incident Command System
- ICS 400 Advanced Incident Command System
- IS 700 An Introduction to the National Incident Management System (FEMA certificate required)
- IS 800a An Introduction to the National Response Framework (FEMA certificate required)

And one of the following:

- All-Hazards Incident Management Team Course, or
- Command & General Staff Functions for Local IMT, or
- ICS 420
