

10-26-18 Trauma Agency Plan Ad Hoc Committee Minutes

Participating: Dr. John McPherson, Susan Ono, Dr. Lee, Captain Sacco, Bill Goodwin, Dr. Zuver, Lynne Drawdy

Recap: The group reviewed actions from previous meetings. Lynne reported that she asked Leah Colston to participate in today's call to provide DOH direction on the trauma agency plan. She has not heard back from Leah, and stated that DOH is still in response mode.

The state trauma advisory meeting was postponed due to the hurricane. Susan stated that they are rescheduling the meeting for November 26 in South Florida.

The draft communication plan developed by Susan Ono was previously distributed to members and was resent during the meeting. Susan explained that the goal is to engage every county by taking advantage of existing meetings at the county level. She said the goal is bi-directional communication. Information from the trauma advisory board can be taken to these county level meetings for their input, and the counties can raise issues to the advisory board. Susan stated that these meetings happen regularly in Orange, Osceola and Seminole Counties, and include the trauma centers and EMS. Dr. Lee stated that this type of meeting did occur in the past in Brevard County but have not been regularly held in the past couple of years. Dr. McPherson stated these began with the fire chiefs calling ad hoc meetings when issues arose, but then became monthly. He said that he did not feel it would be difficult to reinstate these monthly meetings. Captain Sacco stated that Lake County has regular meetings. Susan agreed to reach out to Lindsay Martin at Halifax to find out if there are meetings like this in Volusia County. She will also reach out to the Lawnwood trauma program manager about St. Lucie County, and Dr. Van Dillen in Osceola County. Lynne agreed to reach out to Cory Richter in Indian River County and Chris Stabile in Martin County. Dr. McPherson said that he would also speak with Cory Richter and Dr. Husty in Seminole County. Dr. Zuver will reach out to Todd Stalbaum. Susan suggested that the Coalition be kept in the loop on all communications; Susan will replace Lynne's name with Coalition representative. The group approved the draft plan, and Susan will present this plan at the November 8 trauma advisory board meeting. These individuals should all have been invited to the November meeting.
